










# EUROPEONMETHODOLOGIES FOR PREVENTING BULLYING, PROMOTING NON VIOLENT COMMUNICATION AND CONFLICT MANAGEMENT





European strategies to combat aggression, to promote non-violent communication and conflict management aim to create a safe and welcoming educational environment. They encourage a culture of peace and mutual respect within educational institutions and communities. Key initiatives include:

## **European Union strategy on children's rights:**

This strategy involves initiatives for bullying prevention, whether online or offline. It promotes cooperation between member states to develop legal and educational frameworks that protect children's rights and deter abuse and harassment (EUDA).





#### **Erasmus+ initiative:**

 Erasmus+ supports various projects focused on education and training aimed at preventing bullying and strengthening conflict resolution skills. These initiatives promote social inclusion, peaceful education and civic skills of young Europeans (SALTO Youth).

## European Union strategy against school violence:

 The plan aims to implement concrete measures to reduce violence in schools by developing emotional education programs, encouraging non-violent communication and providing psychological support to students and teachers.
 These initiatives aim to prevent bullying and improve the general atmosphere in the school environment.



#### **SALTO Youth and Mindfulness:**

 The program aims to train young people in non-violent communication and mindfulness for conflict resolution. It aims to teach young people how to promote a harmonious atmosphere and encourage mutual respect using innovative emotion and conflict management strategies (SALTO Jeunesse).

#### **Direct European network and local initiatives:**

At local level, Europe Direct centers organize events and awareness campaigns on bullying, tolerance education and conflict management. These initiatives aim to cultivate a positive school atmosphere by involving students, parents and teachers in various activities.

These strategies, reinforced by programs such as Erasmus+ and SALTO Youth, are crucial for reducing bullying and encouraging harmonious and productive communication within educational institutions and local communities.









# FLORENCE

The "Cradle of the Renaissance", Florence is a city rich in cultural and artistic heritage, located in the center of Tuscany, Italy.
